## **Team Roping**

- This will be a barrier roping
- 3 legal head catches
- 5 second penalty for one leg
- 10 second penalty for broken barrier
- 30 second time limit
- ACTRA rules will be followed

## **Open Breakaway**

- Ropes are to be tied to the saddle horn by a string provided by the director or her stand in. Nylon string will be used. The rope will be tied securely against the saddle horn to allow a tug by the barrier/line judge and not break.
- The string shall be attached to the rope at the end of the rope. The barrier judge may request the rope be retied before permitting contestant to compete.
- A large material flag either white or yellow that is visible to the barrier and flag judges must be attached to the end of the rope breaking away from the saddle horn.
- A legal catch occurs when the loop passes over the calf's head and pulls tight anywhere on the body of the calf. The calf must break the rope away from the horn. A roper breaking the string from the horn is grounds for disqualification. If the rope should dally around the horn, the contestant may ride forward, un-dally the rope, and then stop his or her horse to make the rope break away.
- Time is taken when the flag leaves the saddle horn as the string breaks. The flagman should be positioned down the arena from the timed event chute on the side of the roper from which the rope is fed so the rope is clearly visible when the rope breaks away. If the judge and the director feels this position needs to be changed (if there is not enough room for the judge to stand on a particular side without causing the calf to move away from the judge), they can change the position.
- The catch pen gate shall remain closed and there is a 30 second time limit.
- Stock should not have horns longer than 3 inches. The stock should be as even as possible.
- A ten (10) second penalty for breaking the barrier will be assessed.
- Two (2) loops will be permitted in average ropings and the 30-second rule will be enforced. If the roper intends to use two loops, he or she must carry two ropes and must use the second rope for the second loop. Roper must declare to field/flag judge that two loops are carried. Missing the first loop and the second loop becoming uncoiled, loose, tangled and touching the ground will be a no time. In one (1) head ropings, only one loop will be permitted and the 30-second rule will apply. Roping the calf without releasing the loop from the hand is not permitted.

### Open Barrel Racing

- Timing eye will be used with a backup stopwatch timer
- Barrel pattern is a full clover leaf pattern, 60 ft start/stop 90 ft. from first to second, and 105 ft. from second to third
- 5 second penalty for each barrel knocked over
- Fast time wins - 30 Second time limit (Open Barrels Only)

### Calf Dressing – 4 member team, 2 males and 2 females

- Team members must be 18 years or older.
- Each team will supply their own clothing for the contest (hat, shoes/boots, shirt and pants.
- Participants must be able to run and perform procedures necessary to participate in contest.
- Participants appearing to have broken limbs or evidence of recent injury (cast, ace bandage, support brace, etc) will **automatically be disqualified.**
- Participants and calves to be placed in the arena as directed by arena director
- The Calf Scramble will be refereed by an appointed group of referees.
- Participants will not take tools or equipment into the arena.
- 1 haltered calf will be present for each team participating.
- Calves will be released from chutes with team members allowed to hold on to the halter. Teams will hold on or re-catch their calf by the halter and completely dress the calf in a hat, pair of shoes/boots, shirt and pants.
- Teams will have a designated area in the arena to dress their calf. If the calf is outside of the designated area, team members must lead the calf back into the designated area before they continue dressing their animal.
- The first team leading their calf across the designated finish line completely dressed in all 4 items, will be declared the winner.
- If a participant/team catches a calf by the tail, they will be given a reasonable amount of time to work around to its head; otherwise, the referee will instruct them to release the calf.
- Undo roughness will not be tolerated by the referees. Poor sportsmanship automatically disqualifies any participant

### Dolly Parton Race

- Start behind a flagged line on horseback wearing bra
- Run down on horseback to containers
- Get off of horse and put two (2) water balloons in bra
- Get back on horse and cross the flagged line with two water balloons
- First person back wins
