



## EASTERN SIERRA TRI-COUNTY FAIR HORSE SHOW

**Please fill in all blanks and sign both sides – entries not completed will count as post entries. An open check is preferred.**

When numbers are picked up, verification of payment must be left in show office – no exceptions. If Entries are received by closing date there will be no additional post entry charges for adding or scratching classes if done in the show office by 4:00pm the day before the class is held. You may not post enter Versatility classes. Horse show scratches do not apply. If entries are not received by closing date penalties will apply.

### RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION

**This document waives important legal rights. Read Carefully before signing.**

I AGREE in ponderation for my consideration in the Competition in the Eastern Sierra Tri-County Fair Horse show to the following.

I AGREE that “the Competition” as used herein includes the Competition Management and the property owner(s) as well as their officials, officers, directors, employees, personnel and volunteers.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as rider, driver, handler, vaulter longer, lessee, owner, agent coach, trainer, or as parents or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injury, trauma, pain, suffering, or death “harm”.

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any harm of a nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is to pay any losses damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims or harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while on the show grounds prior to, during, or after the Competition.

I have read the Competition rules about protective equipment, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge the Competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian to a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of the release on the child’s behalf.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured on the show grounds prior, during, or after the Competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the competition.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all Competition Rules and terms and provisions of this entry blank.

A message from the Fairgrounds Management

1. Horse show contestants will be allowed to enter the grounds Wednesday August 28, 2019 at NOON. Arrival prior to this time greatly impacts the ability of the fair staff to complete many tasks necessary to produce this event.
2. It is against the law to bring alcoholic beverages to the Fair Grounds. Violation of this law jeopardized the Fair’s liquor license and could ultimately result in the elimination of such sales. Glass containers of any type are also prohibited.
3. Parking in the barn area creates significant safety hazards & violates State fire Marshall Regulations and generally results in chaos. Short-term parking is allowed to unload stock and supplies. When finished, please proceed to the parking areas east of barn 5 and north of the Mule Days office. Remember parking space is limited. Please park in a manner that is safe and maximizes the available space.

Only one horse per entry blank with a maximum of two riders (if a horse will be shown by more than two riders, use additional forms but staple them together with their checks) The horse is assigned the number. Horses may not cross enter into different age divisions but may show both English & Western Classes in any age divisions. REASON: If classes are small and age break divisions are combined a horse can’t be shown twice.
