Dear Storage Customer:

THANK YOU for being a valued winter storage customer!

The storage season will begin NOW and conclude on April 30, 2021 (unless we cannot host Mule Days). All storage agreements **must be** accompanied with the credit card authorization form or paid in full. Storage will be billed to your credit card on or before the 10th of each month. All rates remain the same for the 2020/2021 season: Indoor \$90 per month, Covered \$80 per month, Outdoor \$70 per month.

Indoor Storage – All 2019 indoor customers have first right of refusal for indoor storage. If you chose not to store with us, please email info@tricityfair.com or call 760-873-3588 to let us know. We will create a waiting list for new customers. Indoor storage items will not be available for use during the storage season. Once storage items are placed indoors, they must stay in place until the season is over. If we have to pull out your stored item, there will be a \$25 charge each way (pull out and put back). The indoor items are hard to get out because of the way they are placed inside of the building.

Covered Storage – There will be a \$25 charge each way for our staff to pull items out and place back into storage. Same as indoor storage, it's not easy to get items out of the barns. If you need to use your stored item throughout the season, we encourage you to store outside.

Outdoor Storage – You may pull your stored item and place back into storage if it's stored outside throughout the season. Please give us a 24-hour notice before removing an item so we can unluck the gates.

We do have onsite security and have installed onsite cameras in all areas. However, we do encourage you to remove items stored on the outside such as propane and batteries. All storage items must be winterized **prior** to being dropped off for storage. The Eastern Sierra Tri-County Fairgrounds/ 18th District Agricultural Association assumes no liability for damages that may occur to items stored at the facility, including weather related damage.
